n the journey from adolescence through adulthood involves considerable individual variation; n psychological development involves physical, sensory, cognitive, social and emotional processes, and the interactions among them; n although adolescence is a time of new discoveries and attainments, it is by no means the end of development;

### **Developing - American Psychological Association (APA)**

cognitive, physical, social, emotional, and behavioral aspects of “normal” adolescent development to help guide professionals working with adolescents in many different contexts There is currently no standard definition of “adolescent” Although often captured as an age range, chronological age is just one way of defining adolescence
